

Traveller Checklist

Items

A) Travel preparation

- Check passport with a minimum validity of six months
- Reconfirm/check-in online with airline
- Personalise luggage
- Travel insurance, mainly medical/cancellation/others
- Foreign currencies/credit card

B) Travel documents

- A valid national passport (valid for more than six (6) months from the date of entry) or internationally recognised travel document valid for travelling to Malaysia
- Visa or Travel Document, where applicable
- Air tickets (with a return or onward ticket)
- Health insurance documents
- Hotel reservations & itineraries documents

C) Medical Requirements

- Medical prescription for personal use
- Yellow fever certification (if coming from or going to/through selected countries, if applicable)

D) No prohibited items

Common list of prohibited items, but not exhaustive. Refer official website of Malaysian Customs Department for full list.

- Narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances
- Pornographic and obscene material
- Counterfeit and pirated goods and goods infringing any of the legally enforceable intellectual property rights
- Antiquities
- Satellite equipments (such as satellite phone) that operate on high radio bandwidths because of their possible interference with the communication networks of security agencies
- Chemicals mentioned in Schedule 1 to the Chemical Weapons Convention of U.N. 1993
- Wild life products such as human skeleton, specified sea-shells, beef, tallow, fat/oil of animal origin, exotic birds except a few specified ones, wild animals, and their parts and products, specified live birds and animals.
